Kia Ora

Our first week of term three has been full on with a trip to Riversdale Arts, P.E skill development with Tony Fryer from Invercargill Hockey Development, an introduction of two new online learning programmes, (Symphony maths, and Lexia reading) and both the junior and senior rooms preparing for next week's camps.

The students were given the opportunity on Tuesday to visit The Riversdale Arts, where they viewed and enjoyed the various artworks on display. They were very impressed with the other primary schools artwork and were inspired by many of the creative pieces.

Tony Fryer will work with the students and teachers once a week over the next two terms and develop skill based sports programmes which include teamwork, leadership, and whole class challenges.

Over term three the students will trial two new online learning programmes. Symphony math is based on further developing classroom teaching in number knowledge and Lexia reading supports reading comprehension, word study and phonics and grammar. At present the senior room students have completed their first placement tests and teachers have planned to include both programmes in math and reading group rotations.

The students are very excited and have been busy preparing/learning for camp next week. On Monday the senior students fly to Wellington, where a full week of exploring the capital city awaits. This is truly a unique opportunity and we are very grateful of the support of the Board of Trustees and the Home and School committee. The junior room have a fantastic week planned in and around Waikaia. We will publish our adventures when we are back.

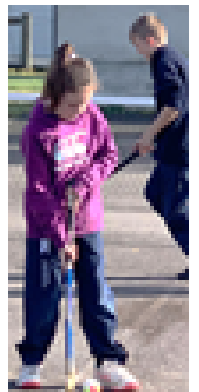
